

PARKING CHARGE AND FAIR ADMISSION

Fair passes will be available to 4-H members the morning of 4-H Fair set-up (July 10) from 9 – 10 a.m. in the Community Building near the 4-H Office, and again one hour before the 4-H Fashion Revue (Tuesday, July 13). Each 4-H family is entitled to 2 weekly passes. **It is important that members pick up their passes.** The Delaware County Fair Board will begin charging admission on Monday July 19, beginning at 4 p.m. There will be a \$5 parking charge and an additional \$2 for each occupant in the vehicle. There is also a \$3 charge for anyone walking onto the grounds. There will be a nominal charge for additional passes if needed.
